How To Obtain an Intrusion Alarm on the Las Cruces Campus – as of January 8, 2020

Need A Burglar Alarm?



All alarms in the NMSU system must comply with rules and regulations set forth in the NMSU Administrative Rules and Procedures, Section 16.02. The alarms must tied into the main NMSU alarm system, they must directly notify the Emergency Dispatch Center, and they must be serviced/maintained regularly. Three offices (Facilities, ICT, and Police) work together to make this easy for you. All you need to do is follow these simple steps:
